RED MOUNTAIN SPA FACT SHEET

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Red Mountain Spa is an extraordinary adult adventure, fitness and health destination located on 55 scenic acres in Southwestern Utah's Mojave Desert, boasting a temperate year-round climate. It is a short two-hour drive northeast of Las Vegas. Nestled at the foot of dramatic red sandstone cliffs adjacent to the 10,000-foot peak of Pine Valley Mountain, the resort is near the entrance to the beautiful Snow Canyon State Park and approximately ten minutes from St. George Airport.

PHILOSOPHY: The staff at Red Mountain Spa is dedicated to providing an optimum learning environment where guests are encouraged to enjoy a variety of programs that complement the natural scenic wonders of the area and enhance a healthy lifestyle. With a nearly 1.5:1 ratio of staff to guests, Red Mountain is able to provide its guests with friendly, genuine service and personal attention.

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FACILITY: The exterior of the buildings comprising Red Mountain Spa are painted a terra cotta color to blend with the surrounding vibrant mountains. Indigenous plants highlight the rolling landscape and pathways linking the buildings. The resort features the Sagestone Spa and Salon, offering a full-range of treatments reflecting an indigenous, distinctive spa experience; 82 newly renovated stylish guest rooms as well as 24 two-bedroom luxury Villas in a total of eleven buildings; a Fitness Center, where classes and health and nutrition consultations are conducted; an outdoor recreation center; and the Training Center, where guests workout on Cybex strength equipment, cardio machines and free weights. The building which houses Canyon Breeze Restaurant and Canyon Cafe, where all meals are served and culinary classes are held, also houses the Red Mountain Conference Center on the second floor. A large gazebo is situated north of the Canyon Breeze complex, and serves as a meeting place for the daily hikes, outdoor classes and lectures, as well as utilized for unique meeting space and outdoor receptions and banquets.

PROGRAMS: Guests at Red Mountain may participate in any of the resort's substantial menu of activities, including outdoor adventure, fitness and mind/body. Guests choose their own adventure, choosing as little or as much activity as they desire.

Outdoor Programs. Red Mountain offers the largest variety of popular and innovative multi-level outdoor adventure programs, including daily guided hikes, rock climbing, kayaking, guided cycling, horseback riding, orienteering, geology and archeology walks, star-gazing, Tai Chi on the Rocks, National Park excursions, backcountry wilderness trips, private guide for hire and custom group trips.

Fitness Programs. Over 50 fitness classes are offered each week at Red Mountain, including a variety of cardiovascular workouts, such as Cardio Core Reebok Board[®], Cardio Salsa and Cross-Training Cardio classes

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and hydro/aqua fit classes; muscle-conditioning workouts, including Strength Circuit, Yoga and Power Pilates® and flexibility classes, including Morning Desert Stretch, Yoga and Total Stretch. New activities are constantly being introduced. Several recent additions include TRX™ Core Conditioning, Boot Camp, Tai Chi on the Rocks, Qi Gong, Balletone®, Nia, Drums Alive, BOSU and Kundalini & Iyengar Yoga.

Healthy Living Classes & Activities. In addition to outdoor and fitness activities, Red Mountain offers inner journeys such as educational, wellness and mind/body classes, spirit hikes, geology walks, breath, meditation, nutrition classes, self-awareness workshops, daily cooking classes and a variety of art and creative expression classes. Red Mountain also features three swimming pools, one indoor and two seasonal outdoor. Guests at Red Mountain may play golf at any of the 15 nearby courses.

SPA:

The elegant spa and salon, Sagestone at Red Mountain debuted in January 2006. Created by Judith Testani of Testani Design Group, Sagestone is located within a unique geodesic dome, featuring chocolate, lime and moss green hues in a relaxing contemporary design.

Guests check in via the top floor, which also houses the full-service salon and retail area. Surrounded by breathtaking vistas, the second floor consists of a relaxation area as well as men's and women's locker rooms with steam. Finally, the ground floor offers fourteen treatment rooms, including two wet rooms, one multi-purpose room, two facial rooms, eight massage rooms and one couple's massage room. There are also two outdoor cabanas and relaxation/meditation areas.

A refreshing new spa treatment menu features over 50 services reflecting an indigenous, distinctive spa experience. Themes include anti-aging, detoxifying, healing, romance and luxury. Treatments are crafted from freshly harvested desert botanicals, mineral-rich muds, clays and salts,

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handcrafted essential oils - all derived from native ingredients.

The professional spa staff is committed to on-going training in new and unique techniques to stay on the cutting-edge of massage and spa therapy. The spa and salon is open daily from 10:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m.

GUEST ROOMS: Red Mountain houses up to 210 guests in a variety of accommodations. Under the keen eye of Judith Testani, guestrooms have undergone a complete redesign and reconfiguration. Using earth and desert tones and natural fabrics, the 82 stylish rooms feature enlarged bathrooms with deep soaking tubs, double vanities with granite countertops, slate floors, separate water closets and new wardrobe closets. All new furniture and linens bring an unpretentious, casual elegance to accommodations, making the property one with the breathtaking natural landscape. Luxury Villa suites are also available for guests seeking adventure and luxury. Single and double occupancy are available. Accommodations are surrounded by desert scape combined with manicured lawns and gardens, and are conveniently situated for easy access to the Canyon Breeze Restaurant, Sagestone at Red Mountain, fitness center and swimming pools. Each guest room features plentiful towels, pillows, television, telephone, complimentary internet and data port and maid service. For the convenience of guests, several guest buildings feature a coin-operated laundry room.

DINING: Prepared by Executive Chef Chad Luethje, Red Mountain Spa offers three healthy, gourmet meals each day in the Canyon Breeze Restaurant.

A healthy breakfast buffet features hot and cold items, a fresh fruit bar and juices. Lunch is served from 11:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m. and features gourmet buffet items as well as fresh salad and fruit bar. Dinner is seated dining and guests choose from an array of selections and featured chef's specials. The Southwest inspired menu is collectively known

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as Adventure Cuisine and includes four categories of choices: Green Cuisine (vegetarian), Power Fuel (sports nutrition), Detox (anti-inflammatory) and Call of the Wild (palate expanding).

MEETINGS: Red Mountain welcomes groups (6-150) to the resort, and provides meeting space to accommodate up to 150 people in the Red Mountain Conference Center, or in either of the private rooms in Canyon Breeze Restaurant and Red Rock Lounge. Several outdoor meeting areas provide the luxury of open air and majestic views to meeting participants.

RED MOUNTAIN OUTFITTERS: Whether new to adventure or an experienced thrill seeker, Red Mountain carries the gear, apparel and footwear to optimize the experience. Outfitters features a trained staff to fit guests with the right equipment for hiking, biking, climbing, adventure travel, aerobics, yoga, tai chi or any other activity at the property. Featuring top-of-the-line merchandise, much of the gear is manufactured with materials such as Dri-Fit, Coolmax[®], Omni-dry[®] and other fabrics designed to keep away moisture from the body and dry quickly, thus enhancing any activity. Red Mountain Outfitters carries brands such as Patagonia[®], Salomon[®], LOWA[®], Asolo[®], Royal Robbins[®], prAna[®], Pearl Izumi[®] and others, including its own logo items, such as hats, t-shirts, jackets, vests, baggage and other items. Footwear is also available, with brands such as Merrell[®] and adidas[®].

Red Mountain Outfitters also carries an array of Southwestern art and gifts, books ranging in content from pleasure, to mind and body, to cookbooks, and a wide range of sundries.

COST: Red Mountain offers a complete spa vacation, which includes healthy gourmet cuisine, bike rental, in-room high-speed internet, full use of facilities, extensive morning hiking, sport activities, healthy living events and classes, lectures, workshops and daily fitness classes. Any day arrival and departure is offered for guests' convenience.

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Accommodations selections include Villa bedrooms and suites and stylish deluxe guest rooms. The 2008 rates range from \$259 to \$709 per person, per night for inclusive room, meals and program. Teens 12 – 17 are welcome when traveling with an adult starting from \$169 per night. Treatments and services at Sagestone Spa and Salon are offered on an a la carte basis. A variety of packages are also available.

ORIENTATION: An orientation and property tour is offered daily at 5:00 pm through Guest Services.

CLIMATE: Red Mountain Spa enjoys a mild, dry desert climate at 3,000 elevation. The average high/low temperature in the spring is 69/35; in the summer, it is 95/62; in the fall it is 86/59; and in the winter, temperatures average 53/35.

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
